Press Release on Recent Situation in Venezuela

6 January 2026

NGO Federation of Nepal, representing civil society organizations across Nepal, expresses its concern regarding recent developments and external actions related to the Venezuela.

We affirm our commitment to the principles of sovereignty, peaceful dialogue and the universal protection of human rights, civic space and civic freedoms. It is our belief that lasting solutions to any nation's challenges must arise from inclusive, domestically-led dialogue, free from external pressure that could undermine stability or exacerbate the suffering of the people.

The unfolding events in Venezuela are deeply concerning and undermine the principles of international laws and the United Nations Charter. We call on the international community and national political actors to respect democratic principles, restore civic freedoms, uphold the rule of law and ensure meaningful participation of citizens and civil society in Venezuela's democratic processes. At the same time, all actors must respect Venezuela's sovereignty, adhere to international law, and support peaceful, democratic, and Venezuelan-led solutions.

NGO Federation of Nepal stands in solidarity with the people and civil society of Venezuela in their struggle for democracy, peace, justice and an open civic space.

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
